General Information

There is no charge to attend Family Services, which are listed in bold type above, and all are welcome.

There are charges for Childcare & Youth Programs, which are led by experienced childcare practitioners and include lunch, snacks, age-appropriate games, and park visits (for grades K – 6). These charges are as follows:

“Pass” for all Programs: \$115 for 1st child, \$105 per child for siblings
 Evenings \$11 per child per evening; \$10 per child for siblings
 Morning/lunchtime: \$32 per child per morning/lunchtime; \$27 per child for siblings

Please Commit to Attending at Least One Wednesday Morning Minyan a Year

Netivot Shalom has a morning minyan every Wednesday at 7:15AM. The time has been set so that people can come before starting their work day. It is usually over by 8AM.

People who have yahrtzeits for a loved one or who have recently lost a loved one come to the minyan to say kaddish.

The ritual committee is asking each Jewish congregation member over the age of 13 to pick at least one Wednesday in the year and commit to be at the Wednesday morning minyan on that day.

This small commitment of at least one minyan a year will spread out among all of us in the congregation the obligation to help us have a minyan every week so that mourners can say kaddish.

We hope every Jewish adult in the congregation will participate by committing to attend at least once a year. You will receive a reminder by phone or email (whichever you choose) the week before the date you select to help you remember to come that Wednesday morning.
